UH's Bolla to take  
a leave of absence

HONOLULU — University of Hawai'i women's basketball coach Jim Bolla will take a leave of absence while he recovers from an undisclosed medical procedure, the university announced Saturday.

Associate head coach Pat Charity will serve as interim head coach.

"This is something that came up unexpectedly, and on the advice of doctors, I'm choosing to take care of it immediately," Bolla said. "I have full confidence in Pat and my staff to carry on in my absence."

Bolla is 38-37 in his third season as Rainbow Wahine coach. Hawai'i is 9-12 overall and 3-6 in the Western Athletic Conference this season.

Charity has served an assistant since 2004. She was head coach at Western Michigan from 1990-97.
