Laurie Ho, Coordinator for Garden Island RC&D

Laurie earned a BS in Agricultural Technology from the University of Hawai'i at Manoa. She has been with the US Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) for 30 years. Working for NRCS has taken her to organizational meetings, trainings and worksites including the Territory of Guam, giving her a national perspective on agriculture, as well as the ability to integrate and relate this knowledge to others. Having participated in the Agricultural Leadership Foundation of Hawai'i's (ALFH) Agricultural Leadership program in 1991, she enhanced her skills in facilitation and ability, learning a statewide perspective of agriculture. Since moving to Kauai County in 1983, she took a position in 1997 as Coordinator in a USDA program called Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) and presently work with grassroots community-based organizations on projects such as advocating the establishment of a viable forest industry on Kauai and provide financial oversight for the Kauai Invasive Species Committee (KISC); worked with the County of Kauai's Office of Economic Development to apply for Empowerment zone designation and earned Kauai County USDA's Rural Champion Community status. Laurie is a member of the Kauai County Farm Bureau since 1991 and serves as an advisor and resource person to the Kauai Agricultural Advisory Committee and Kauai County Farm Bureau Board of Directors. She also serves as a Citizen's Advisory Committee member for the Lihue Town Core Urban Design Plan looking at enhancing the livability of Lihu'e, and is the Kauai representative to the Board of Agriculture.
