Kauai Economic Development Board is hosting the 2017 Kauai Energy Conference on June 19<sup>th</sup> at the Marriott in Lihue from 9am-4:30pm. The conference is for leading local businesses and organizations that want to continue improving their energy use and reduce their carbon emissions. The conference has three tracks – *Energy Savings, Clean Transportation, and Low Carbon Future.*

- **Energy Savings** –Brush up on the latest opportunities to reduce energy usage and help your bottom line. How do you use detailed energy consumption data to create savings? What are the latest efficiency incentives from KIUC? Where are utility rates headed? What about PV systems and energy storage for businesses?
- **Clean Transportation** – How can Kauai move to clean, low carbon fuels for ground transportation? Is there demand for electric vehicles and infrastructure in the visitor sector? In retail? In multi-unit housing facilities? What about car sharing and automomous vehicles? What clean fuel choices do we have for heavy-duty vehicles such as busses and service trucks?
